Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 1: Revise Management Directive (MD) 13.1 to require that

property inventories should include independent verification of the property by someone other than the

property holder.

Agency Response

Dated January 29, 2010: MD 13.1, "Property Management" was revised to require that

property inventories should include independent verification of the property by someone other than the property holder, and was put in final office review and concurrence on October 29, 2009. The Office of Administration anticipates approval of the MD in February, and publication by March

2010.

OIG Analysis: The proposed corrective action addresses the intent of

OIG's recommendation. This recommendation will be closed when OIG receives a copy of the final MD 13.1 and determines that it requires that property inventories include independent verification of the property by someone other

than the property holder.
