UNITS 2 AND 3 COMBINED LICENSES APPLICATION REVIEW

Dear Mr. Smith:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is reviewing an application submitted by the South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G) acting for itself and as an agent for South Carolina Public Service Authority (also referred to as Santee Cooper) for two combined licenses (COLs) to construct and operate two new nuclear power units at its Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station, Units 2 and 3 (VCSNS) site in Fairfield County, South Carolina. As part of its review of the proposed action, the NRC staff has prepared a draft environmental impact statement (DEIS). The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Charleston District (USACE), is a cooperating agency on the DEIS. The DEIS includes analyses of relevant environmental issues, including potential impacts to historic properties, and documents the NRC and USACE staffs' determination regarding the suitability of the proposed site for the construction and operation of two new nuclear units.

A copy of the DEIS is enclosed. In chapter 2 of the DEIS you will find a discussion of the area of potential effect (APE). Chapters 4 and 5 discuss impacts to historic properties from construction and operation. The NRC staff is using the process required by the National Environmental Policy Act, of 1969, as amended (NEPA), for the preparation of the EIS. By letter dated January 12, 2009, the NRC staff notified you that in accordance with Title 36 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (36 CFR) 800.8(c), the NRC staff is using the NEPA process to comply with its obligations under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (NHPA), in lieu of the procedures set forth in 36 CFR 800.3 through 800.6. According to 10 CFR 50.10 (a)(2)(vii), transmission lines are not included in the definition of construction for the purposes of obtaining an NRC license. NRC would not have regulatory authority over any transmission lines associated with VCSNS Units 2 and 3. Consequently, the NRC considers transmission lines to be outside the NRC's APE and therefore not part of the NRC's consultation under the NHPA.

The NRC staff has conducted an environmental audit at the site and has reviewed historic and archaeological records. Under the provisions of the NHPA, the NRC staff's preliminary determination is that no historic properties will be adversely affected by the proposed action.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 51.28 and 36 CFR 800.2(c), the NRC wishes to ensure that Indian Tribes that might have an interest in any potential historic properties in the APE are afforded the opportunity to identify their concerns, provide advice on the identification and evaluation of historic properties, including those of traditional religious, and cultural importance, and, if necessary, participate in the resolution of any adverse effects to such properties.
