I assume we're talking about the LTC license. I'm NOT the expert on the process--the project manager should be. But, my understanding is that there would be an amendment to approve the DP, which would then allow the licensee to do the cleanup and final status surveys and set up the institutional controls (develop monitoring plan, etc.). I think another amendment, to create the LTC license, would come after everything else is done. If this is critical, you should ask the PM for the more official word.
