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Please amend our Radioactive Materials License *NRC # 07-14900-01, Bayhealth Medical Center – Milford Memorial Hospital*, 21 West Clarke Avenue, Milford, DE, 19963 to reflect the following:

- We wish to discontinue the Radioactive Materials License NRC # 07-14900-01 (Transferor) as noted above and be joined with our sister facility NRC # 07-14850-01, Bayhealth Medical Center – Kent General Hospital (Transferee), located at 640 South State Street, Dover, DE 19901
 - Kent General Hospital and Milford Memorial Hospital are part of one parent company under the name Bayhealth Medical Center. Presently, Kent General Hospital is named on the license as Bayhealth Medical Center – Kent General Hospital and Milford Memorial Hospital is named on the license as Bayhealth Medical Center – Milford Memorial Hospital.
 - There will be no changes in support personnel or duties at this facility with regard to the licensed program.
 - All current activities (organization, location, facilities, and equipment) that fall under the radioactive materials license will remain unchanged. There is and will continue to be collaboration to coordinate and duplicate procedures between the Transferor and the Transferee.
 - Surveys, wipe tests and other quality control will remain unchanged and survey procedures will be consistent with license conditions. All sources will remain in place or in storage as currently used by the Transferor.
 - There will be no decommissioning of NRC # 07-14900-01(Transferor).
 Both facilities are owned by the same entity. We are not closing or stating disposition of sources.



 All license conditions will be maintained at both facilities and will fall under the jurisdiction of the Transferee.

We would like to be listed as an area of use on the license of our sister facility, Bayhealth Medical Center – Kent General Hospital.

In no way should this license be terminated before re-licensure under the conjoint license merging the two campuses of Bayhealth Medical Center. It can expire concurrent with the new entity.
