MWIS comments on the "SECY Paper for New Jersey Agreement Application" (NSIR-09-0118).

The draft SECY paper requests Commission approval to publish the proposed Agreement with the State of New Jersey and a summary of the draft NRC staff assessment of the New Jersey regulatory program in the federal register. MWISB has reviewed the SECY paper and attachments and recommends concurrence on the SECY paper.

A MWISB staff member participated in the working group that reviewed the New Jersey agreement application for compatibility with NRC requirements. The MWISB staff member was responsible for the review of section, "4.7 Event and Allegation Response Program Elements." Based on criteria in FSME Procedure SA-700 "Processing an Agreement," the New Jersey event and allegation response program was determined to be compatible with NRC's requirements.

Another working group member reviewed two license conditions to implement Increased Controls and Fingerprinting and Criminal History Records Check requirements for risksignificant radioactive materials for certain State licensees under the proposed Agreement. These license conditions were determined to be compatible with NRC requirements and will replace the Orders that NRC issued to licensees in the State of New Jersey.

The working group concluded that the State of New Jersey's radiation protection program is compatible with the program of the NRC and adequate to protect public health and safety with respect to the materials covered by the proposed Agreement.
