Hello,

As a follow-up from yesterday's meeting - I had a chance to talk with Dennis about how current you have to stay and provide NRC with new procedures and such.

The expectation is as I had hoped - the intent is to have a process in place that commits the program to keeping current with guidance, procedures, regulations - that they will be updated as needed for the program and to meet compatibility/adequacy requirements. For example, Dennis said that with regulations, even if one came in before the Agreement was signed, you would still have the 3 years to adopt the regulation. NRC wouldn't expect you to get it done before the Agreement.

Just make sure you have that kind of commitment in place - I remember seeing something similar in rule space and maybe licensing.

So, for the agreement, nothing needs to be done for us on IP 87135 and 87136.
