

**Supporting in-situ recovery of uranium  
by Powertech (USA) Inc. in Fall River and Custer Counties, South Dakota**

WHEREAS Fall River and Custer Counties have been endowed with the natural resource uranium which is an alternative source of energy which can help the United States meet an increasing demand for electricity; and,

WHEREAS Powertech (USA) Inc. desires to mine uranium on the Dewey-Burdock site in Fall River and Custer Counties utilizing the in-situ recovery method; and,

WHEREAS the economic base of the State of South Dakota and Fall River and Custer Counties will be enhanced as Powertech (USA) Inc. employs its citizens, purchases goods and services, and provides an expanded tax base; and,
