SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MARCH 2, 2010, PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE VICTORIA COUNTY STATION EARLY SITE PERMIT APPLICATION

On March 2, 2010, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 1 public meeting at NRC Headquarters in Rockville, MD. The purpose of the meeting was for Exelon to brief the NRC staff on what is expected to be submitted in their application for an Early Site Permit (ESP). The meeting agenda is provided as Enclosure 1 (ML100810283) and the Exelon presentation slides are provided as Enclosure 2 (ML100810313)

By letter dated October 13, 2009, Exelon Generation Company, LLC in response to the NRC's Regulatory Information Summary 2009-03, informed the NRC that it, intended to submit an ESP application for Victoria County Station by no later than March 31, 2010. Based on the information provided by Exelon, the NRC scheduled this public meeting to provide Exelon with the opportunity to brief the staff on their anticipated submittal.

The meeting began with opening remarks from staff in the Office of New Reactors. This was followed by an introduction of meeting attendees (see Attachment 2 ML100810286) and a presentation from Exelon representatives. Exelon briefed those in attendance on the history, benefits and overview of the ESP Application. This included updates which were made to several areas of the ESP application to address other applicant RAIs and COLA acceptance review issues, the plant parameter envelope (PPE) approach and their decision not to pursue an Limited Work Authorization. This was followed by a description of the six parts of the application which will include complete and integrated emergency plans as well as site safety and environmental evaluations based on data and analyses used for the Victoria County Station

COLA which were updated as needed to incorporate COLA acceptance review information and site studies. More details about Exelon's ESP application can be found in the attached presentation.
