In a letter dated September 29, 2009 you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. Based on our review of the final status survey documentation submitted in support of the request, the staff has determined that you have satisfactorily demonstrated that any residual byproduct material remaining in the facility is below the NRC's unrestricted use dose limits specified in 10 CFR Part 20, Subpart E "Radiological Criteria for License Termination."
