Reference our conversation about Studsvik, Inc. at the March 2, 2010, NRC meeting in Erwin. As promised, some background/historical information in a 1" binder was sent to you via FedEx today. It should arrive Wednesday. FedEx Tracking No. is: 872023437662.

As discussed, we believe it is important that the cumulative environmental impacts of Studsvik, co-located with NFS on NFS property, be considered in any environmental assessment or (preferably) environmental impact statement, regarding NFS licensing.

It is our understanding that NFS owns 10% of Studsvik, according to Studsvik President, Maurice Carlson, in an Erwin Record article on Feb. 6, 2007. Also, David Wise, former NFS VP for Fuel Mfg, signed the application for the 2008 operating permit as the Studsvik VP of Operations.

The majority of the general public in Erwin and Unicoi County have no idea what Studsvik is, who owns it, how or when it came here, or what it does. When asked, they immediately say "I think it's part of NFS."

While we did include some information about Studsvik in the public input we provided to you and Mr. James Park on Nov. 17, 2009, we would appreciate your review and consideration of these additional details for the public good. We believe it is information the NRC should know as it considers NFS' request for a license renewal -- a major federal action.
