The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the response to Request for Additional Information (RAI) 200. RAI 200 addresses the Quality Assurance Program Description (QAPD), as discussed in Section 17.5 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

The referenced letter anticipated that the response to RAI 200, Question 17.5-6 would be provided by March 19, 2010. The submittal date was based on staff review and endorsement of NEI 06-14, Revision 8 to support revision of the UniStar Nuclear Energy QAPD. Based on our current understanding of the staff review schedule for NEI 06-14, Revision 8, a response to RAI 200, Question 17.5-6, including a revised QAPD, will be provided to the NRC by April 30, 2010.
