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SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT
STATEMENT AND BIOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT RELATED TO THE REVIEW
OF THE COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION FOR VIRGIL C. SUMMER
NUCLEAR STATION, UNITS 2 AND 3

Dear Mr. Herrington:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is reviewing an application submitted by the South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G), acting for itself and as an agent for South Carolina Public Service Authority (also referred to as Santee Cooper) for two combined licenses (COLs) to construct and operate two new nuclear units at its Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station (VCSNS) site in Fairfield County, South Carolina. As part of its review of the proposed action, the NRC staff have prepared a draft environmental impact statement (DEIS) and biological assessment (BA), which are enclosed. The DEIS includes analyses of relevant environmental issues and documents the NRC staff's determination regarding the suitability of the proposed site for the construction and operation of two new nuclear units. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Charleston District, is a cooperating agency on the DEIS.

The NRC and USACE staff have not identified listed species or critical habitats under the Federal Endangered Species Act (ESA) of 1973, that could potentially be affected by activities proposed on the project site. However, the staff have identified 14 species listed as threatened or endangered under ESA, as well as two candidate species, potentially occurring in areas that may be traversed by a future route selection process for six transmission lines proposed for development as part of the action. The staff have determined that the transmission lines, depending on the exact routes ultimately selected, may affect but are not likely to adversely affect the following 13 of the 14 threatened or endangered species potentially present in areas traversed by possible routes: wood stork (*Mycteria americana*), red-cockaded woodpecker (*Picoides borealis*), flatwoods salamander (*Ambystoma cingulatum*), Carolina heelspitter (*Lasmigona decorata*), pool sprite (*Amphianthus pusillus*), smooth coneflower (*Echinacea laevigata*), Schweinitz's sunflower (*Helianthus schweinitz*), black-spored quillwort (*Isoetes melanospora*), pondberry (*Lindera melissifolia*), rough-leaved loosestrife (*Lysimachia asperulifolia*), Canby's dropwort (*Oxypolis canbyi*), harperella (*Ptilimnium nodosum*), and relict trillium (*Trillium reliquum*). The staff concluded that there should be no affect on the fourteenth species, piping plover (*Charadrius melodus*). The transmission lines could also potentially affect but not adversely affect two candidate species: Georgia aster (*Aster georgianus*) and bog asphodel (*Narthecium americanum*).

The NRC and USACE staff's conclusion regarding the potential for adverse effects relies on an assumption that the applicant will use flexibility when selecting the exact future routes for the transmission lines.
