By letter dated December 31, 2007, as supplemented by letter dated March 27, 2008, and April 16, 2008, Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Ltd. (MHI) submitted an application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a standard design certification of the United States - Advanced Pressurized Water Reactor (US-APWR), pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 52, "Licenses, Certifications, and Approvals for Nuclear Power Plants." Subsequent to the original application, MHI has submitted Revisions 1 and 2 of the US-APWR Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) by letters dated August 29, 2008, and October 27, 2009, in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under Accession Numbers ML082480524 and ML093070198. The revisions to the FSAR include changes associated with responses to the NRC Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) submitted through August 2009.

Based on our review of the application, the NRC staff prepared the enclosed Safety Evaluation Report (SER), with Open Items for Chapter 16, "Technical Specifications," ADAMS Accession Number ML100830471. Unless otherwise stated in the SER with Open Items, the NRC staff's review was based on Revision 2 of the application and MHI's responses to RAIs. The SER with Open Items is being provided to support the upcoming meeting of the subcommittee of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) scheduled to be held in June 2010. The ACRS Full Committee meeting will be held at a later date. Issuance of this SER is an important milestone in the NRC staff's review to determine whether MHI's application meets the Commission's regulations.

The open items identified in the SER have been previously provided to you as RAIs with the same identifying number. These open items are expected to be resolved during the Phase 4 review of your application. As such, the schedule we have established for your application assumes technically correct and complete responses to the RAIs prior to the start of Phase 4 review of Chapter 16 of the FSAR. If you are unable to provide an answer prior to the start of the Phase 4 review, it is expected that a date for receipt of this information will be provided so that the NRC staff can assess how this information will impact the overall review schedule.
