Dear Mr. Morris:

By letter dated September 15, 2009, the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) submitted NEI 08-09, "Cyber Security Plan for Nuclear Power Reactors," Revision 3, dated September 2009 to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for staff review and approval. Subsequently, NEI has provided responses to NRC requests for additional information (RAIs) by letter dated March 5 and March 10, 2010.

Subsequently, industry identified the need to provide supplemental information to clarify responses previously provided. In addition, as result of industry reviews of staff RAIs concerning cyber security controls, additional proposed changes to NEI 08-09, Sections 3.1.6 and 4.2 have been identified. Please find attached proposed changes to NEI 08-09, Appendix A, for these items.

With this submittal, along with the previous two NEI letters, the industry believes that all NRC RAIs associated with its review of NEI 08-09, Appendix A have been addressed. A letter in reply confirming the conclusion of the staff review of Appendix A of NEI 08-09, Revision 3 is requested by April 2, 2010.



The industry team is developing responses to the RAIs on the cyber security controls, and plans to submit proposed responses on or about April 2, 2010. By April 16, the industry team wishes to have resolved any issues resulting from the responses to the RAIs regarding the cyber security controls. NEI will then submit, on behalf of the industry, a final NEI 08-09, Revision 6 on or about April 19. Revision 6 will incorporate changes identified in all generic RAI responses, as well as any necessary administrative and clerical changes. NEI will request a letter from NSIR by April 29 indicating that NEI 08-09, Revision 6 addresses all generic issues, and that the document is recommended for endorsement.
