Elise:

N1-11894 (aka. Nichols #1) is an old artesian stockwell (circa. 1967). To my knowledge , Uranerz has not provided any completion details, driller's logs or geophysical logs for this well. I suspect this generation of well would have had slot-cut casing or jet-shot perforations across the entire sandy interval between 191-310ft. I opine Nichols #1 is completed in both the F Sand and the C Sand. You may wish to call Mike Thomas to see if he has any additional useful information on this well.

Hi Mark,

We are trying to determine which sand interval the well N1-11894 at Nichols Ranch is screened in for the SEIS. The table D6-2 says the screen is 191-310 bgs and located in the F sand. The text apparently says it is located in the C sand. Do you have any knowledge of whether it is the F, C or both? I found this permit on the SEO, but I could not find the well completion report.
