Don McKenzie, the Administrator for DEQ Land quality Division, has offered to be the point person for state agencies on Nuclear Regulatory Commission NEPA activities for uranium projects.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued 3 draft SEISs for insitu uranium projects in Wyoming. The project names and county locations are Moore Ranch in Campbell County, Hank-Nichols in Johnson and Campbell Counties and Lost Creek in Sweetwater County. The SEISs are a follow-up to the GEIS published this year for potential "regional" uranium project areas in Wyoming, South Dakota, Nebraska and New Mexico.

Don will work with the Governor's Office to coordinate responses from other State agencies that may have an interest in these projects. If you have an interest in reviewing uranium projects and participating in any NEPA related reviews, please either email Don or give him a call and he will add you to his contact list. If you know of other people or agencies I may have overlooked, please pass along the information. Contact information for both Don and me follow. Steve
