Recommendation 2: Establish an alternative to the Department of Energy

(DOE) sponsored MC&A inspector training to be used as

needed.

Agency Response Dated

February 25, 2010: Self-study guides will be developed to replace course

content in each DOE-sponsored MC&A and related class that is not routinely offered. This approach will not only address the issue of difficulty in scheduling the classes offered by DOE, but also address the issue of having few U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff needing to take the class at a time – which prevents contracting with DOE laboratories to conduct the class specifically for NRC due to costs. This work is expected to be completed in

December 2011.

OIG Analysis: The corrective action addresses the intent of this

recommendation. This recommendation will be closed when

NRC develops and implements self-study guides and procedures developed to replace course content in each DOE-sponsored MC&A and related class that is not routinely

offered.
