Behram:

The submittal today will address the additional areas that you note. There are a few remaining open items that address spill impacts, updated surface water data, and wetlands. As noted on the Table that Jon provided, we expect to have to you by the first week of September.

There was no attachment to your email but we are working on our responses to the SER open issues identified by Uranium Recovery. In addition to the May public meeting, there have been two others in July and August. We do not have the meeting summaries from those conferences yet but are working on responses. Many of the issues are interrelated and we have notified Doug Mandeville that we intend to respond to them with a single submittal to avoid overlap and confusion. We did not intend to submit any of those responses with the submittal today since they were not identified as additional information necessary to complete the SEIS. Our understanding was that they were strictly open issues in the SER. We do plan to incorporate the responses to these open issues in the Technical and Environmental Reports when complete.

I am concerned that we do not adversely affect the efforts to complete the SEIS. If there are specific SER open issues responses that have a bearing on that, please let us know and we will expedite preparation of those responses.
