Subject: 2010-03-31 Conference Call re South Bend Reservoir

Steve,

We have contacted BRA re a conference call on the South Bend Reservoir. As we discussed, the primary purpose of the call is to get an open, candid characterization of the reservoir to help determine if the reservoir needs to be included in the flood assessment calculation. Tuesday, April 20, 2010, at 9am CDT (10am EDT) works for Luminant and BRA so I am proposing that day and time. We will provide BRA some background material regarding what is currently in the FSAR, some appropriate SRPs and the importance of the discussion. I know you need to check your schedules so please let me know if this works and if not, please propose an alternative.

If it works (and not to delay the South Bend Reservoir discussion), we may want to discuss the large tank failure analysis performed for the US-APWR DCD. During our last public conference call, some statements were made that indicated that the COLA reviewers for the NRC felt that portions of the DCD analysis might not be conservative. MHI is reviewing their analysis in light of that conference call and may have some questions or updates to discuss. When you prepare the notice for the South Bend Reservoir public conference call, please include this tank failure analysis discussion. If we don't need the discussion, it is easier to delete it from the agenda than it is to add it later.

I believe the call should include the NRC (and appropriate contractors), Luminant, MNES, MHI and BRA. The list of individuals from BRA is not firm but as of now, Jim Forte, David Wheelock, Matt Phillips and maybe a couple of others are planning on participating. Give me a call if you have any questions or feedback.
