In accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.1009(a)(1), the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) hereby designates Deana M. Dennis as the person “responsible for administration of [NARUC’s] responsibility to provide electronic files of documentary material.”

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Initial Certification of Deana M. Dennis

NARUC has been in communication with Daniel J. Graser, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission’s Licensing and Support Network Administrator to obtain technical guidance to implement the requirements of § 2.1003.

Due to NARUC’s small staff and limited technical support resources, we have not yet been able to launch our Licensing Support Network (LSN) connection, but intend to do so as soon as possible. NARUC will ensure that all documents carry our unique identification number and we will cooperate with the advisory review process under §2.1011(d). Given that most aspects of this proceeding are currently stayed under the February 16, 2010 Order, NARUC has not yet identified any documentary material that would need to be uploaded to the LSN.¹ We do certify our intention to comply with the requirements of 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003 and will make a good faith effort to do so once we identify such materials.

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¹ The LSN seems primarily targeted to materials compiled in the discovery period for use during the evidentiary hearings, not at this procedural phase of the process. See, e.g. 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e), “Each potential party, interested governmental participant or party shall continue to supplement its documentary material made available to other participants via the LSN with any additional material created after the time of its initial certification in accordance with paragraph (a)(1) through (a)(4) of this section until the discovery period in the proceeding has concluded” (*emphasis added*).

Certification of Licensing Support Network Supplementation

Each potential party is required by 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e) to supplement on a continuing basis its documentary material made available on the Licensing Support Network (LSN) with additional material created or discovered after the date of its initial certification. Pursuant to the requirements of 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e), the Pre-Application Presiding Officer (PAPO) Board has ordered in the Revised Second Case Management Order dated July 6, 2007, that each potential party make such supplementation on or before the first day of each month following its initial certification and file to that effect. On information and belief, NARUC has not yet identified any documentary material as specified in 10 C.F.R. §2.1003 for upload to the LSN, and therefore has not uploaded or supplemented any documentary material to the LSN. While most aspects of this proceeding are currently stayed under the February 16, 2010 Order, NARUC will still make every good faith effort to identify and make electronically available the material specified in 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e), and to supplement any such material following our initial submissions.
