
1. It appears that you wish to use some RAM at temporary job sites. In Item 3 of the application form, please specify in addition to your 2 places of use that you wish to use RAM at temporary job sites within the State of Indiana.
2. It appears in item 5 of your request that you wish to be authorized for atomic numbers 1-104 including sealed sources. Please be advised that sealed source need to be listed separately on your NRC license with manufacturers' names, model numbers, number of sources and quantity per source. Also please provide the sealed source and device registry number.
3. Items 6.B. through 6.I and 6.L. listed on your license was not included in your request. Please clarify if your intent is to delete these isotopes from your NRC license.
4. In item 6 of your request, please delete all reference to Indians Codes and EPA reference.
5. In item 6 of your request, under main use, please modify your request to use RAM at temporary job sites, to temporary job sites (TJS) in the State of Indiana. Also, please specify which sealed sources will be used at TJS and for what purposes. Also please specify whether or not analytical samples will be gathered and transported from TJS. There is no need to discuss DOT requirements.
6. It appears that John Ruyack is to be removed from your NRC license. Please clarify.
7. For the addition of Mary Stiker, Ron Clark and Kathy Benassi to your NRC license, please delete the curriculum vitae and only list their training and experience using RAM. Please also make sure personal information is not included.
8. For Item 10, Occupational Dose, please use the wording as outlined in the Section Radiation Safety Program – Occupation Dose in NUREG 1556, Vol. 7 under Response from Applicant.
9. Your request included diagrams of laboratory areas. Please identify the address for each lab and discuss what changes took place that necessitated the inclusion of these diagrams.

10. Since you committed to using radiation monitoring instruments that meet the specifications in Appendix M to NUREG 1557, Vol. 7, there is no need to list your instrumentation. Please delete the list(s) from your request.
