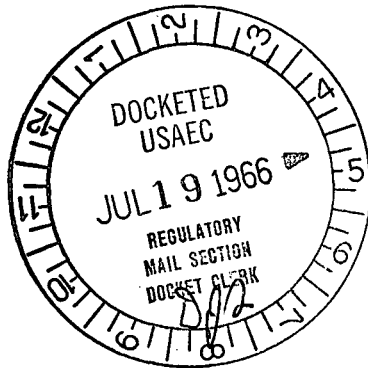
Union Carbide Corporation has recently been advised of the termination of the Fissionchemistry Research Program which was a joint effort between our laboratory and Aerojet-General Nucleonics. As a material balance area of station LBZ (AGN - San Ramon) we have 27 UO<sub>2</sub> foils containing a total of 3.04 gms U and 2.83 gms U<sup>235</sup>. We would like to continue using this material for further company-sponsored work and request your authorization to transfer them to our SNM-639 ZWN (Lease Agreement No. 163). We have discussed this transfer with cognizant personnel at Aerojet-General and they have no objections.

Upon your approval, we will initiate the required OR-640 and AEC-388.
