SUBJECT: PROPOSED UNION CARBIDE CORPORATION LETTER

I discussed the proposed letter, copy attached, prepared by Rod Mason, with Robert Vessels, N. Y. State Coordinating Council on Atomic Energy on September 9, 1963. He indicated that N. Y. had no immediate plans for converting the byproduct and source material portion of the application to a state license form. We both agreed that bringing the "bucket" question to the attention of Union Carbide at this time, when as far as we knew there was no problem over this matter, would probably just cause concern and confusion. Therefore, we decided not to contact Carbide at this time, but wait until the license was up for renewal to inform Carbide of the division of jurisdiction. I informed Rod Mason of this decision.
