The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the responses to Request for Additional Information (RAI) 101 and RAI 104. RAI 101 addresses Groundwater and RAI 104 addresses Liquid Radioactive Release, as discussed in Section 2.4 of the Final Safety Analysis Report, as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

The referenced letter anticipated that the responses would be provided by April 2, 2010. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize responses to RAI 101 and RAI 104. Responses to RAI 101, Questions 02.04.12-9 through 02.04.12-11, and RAI 104, Question 02.04.13-4 will be provided by May 3, 2010.
