Amendment No. 4 to License SNM-639 was issued on June 27, 1980, in response to your June 2, 1980 application for amendment. (Your June 2 application superseded earlier applications dated December 28, 1979 and April 2, 1980). A minor amendment fee of \$1,400 was paid for review and approval of the request.
