Dear Commissioners and Staff:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 72.4 and 10 CFR 72.44(d), this letter provides the report of the quantity of radionuclides released to the environment in liquid and gaseous effluents due to the operation of the Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP) Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI). As documented in the DCPP ISFSI Final Safety Analysis Report, the DCPP ISFSI multi-purpose canisters (MPCs) are designed and constructed to ensure no release of radioactive gas, liquids, or solid waste effluents.

For the year 2009, there were no releases of liquid or gaseous radionuclides to the environment from the operation of the DCPP ISFSI.
