Dear Mr. Barker:

The Regional Assistance Committee has completed the review of the updated State of Minnesota Emergency Operations Plan dated 09/09. Also reviewed were the updated Wright and Sherburne County Emergency Response Plans, which are site specific to the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant and the updated Dakota and Goodhue County Emergency Response Plans, which are site specific to the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant.

We concur with the State's assessment that no significant changes have been made to the Concept of Operations for the State of Minnesota Emergency Operations Plan or the Wright, Sherburne, Dakota and Goodhue County Emergency Response Plans regarding response to nuclear power plant related radiological emergencies, and that the plans are in compliance with NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Rev. 1, Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness In Support of Nuclear Power Plants.

The Minnesota Emergency Operations Plan that you received is a restricted document under Minnesota Statue, Chapter 13, Section 13.37 and is for the use of authorized agencies and persons not the general public. As such, please maintain control and limit access to the plan.






**Verification of Plan Approval**


