Retraction of Emergency License Amendment Request 10-02
One Time Revision to Technical Specification 3.8.1, "AC Sources – Operating"

On March 11, 2010, PG&E submitted Emergency License Amendment Request 10-02, One Time Revision to Technical Specification 3.8.1, "AC Sources - Operating." The license amendment request (LAR) was submitted in anticipation of requiring more than the allowed 72 hours to implement modifications associated with the discovery of a nonconservative technical specification (TS). At approximately 13:45, on March 12, 2010, following modifications, operators exited TS Action 3.8.1. Therefore, PG&E is no longer requesting an emergency license amendment and hereby retracts emergency LAR 10-02.

This letter was submitted March 12, 2010, but incorrectly specified it contained an "enclosure", and is therefore being re-submitted.

PG&E makes no regulatory commitments (as defined by NEI 99-04) in this letter. This letter includes no revisions to existing regulatory commitments.
