PURPOSE: To discuss (1) draft proposed rule language for the ongoing effort to modify the ECCS acceptance criteria at 10 CFR 50.46(b); (2) NRC responses to major comments received on an Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR) published on August 13, 2009 (74 FR 40765); and (3) to discuss the elements of a prospective generic letter related to the potential embrittlement of fuel rod cladding during postulated loss of coolant accidents (LOCA).
