Jenny,

The license amendment request should be granted (or denied) promptly after the NRC makes all findings required by its review; that is, after the NRC completes its safety and environmental reviews. Practically speaking, this means the NRC would issue its decision on the DP at approximately the same time its releases the final SER and EIS (or, in the event these documents are not issued simultaneously, the later of these two documents).
