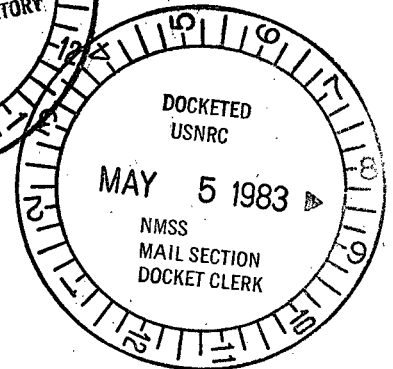
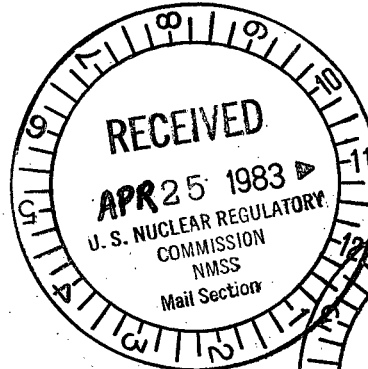
Subj: UCC FNMC Plan, Revision

Dear Mr. Jackson:

The subject plan has been under revision to incorporate recent changes to operations at our Sterling Forest facility. The changes that we have discussed in recent telephone conversations have been made and these revised pages are enclosed.

Since this revision incorporates several operations and procedures which formerly have appeared as MPP license conditions, we request that these license conditions which are redundant with the plan be eliminated. The license conditions that could be eliminated are 3.1, 3.4, 6.1, 6.3 and 7.1.

As a final order of business in this revision to the plan, we would like to incorporate changes to those sections pertaining to solid waste material that is assayed, packaged and stored in readiness for disposal. The recent NRC decision (01/13/83) which provides for establishing holding accounts for such waste can be applied to three categories of waste that is generated in our facility; namely, irradiated uranium as UO₂ from the waste form process that is destined for recovery at Savannah River, low level contaminated solid waste from the target plating operation and irradiated uranium discards from the waste form process that is mixed in concrete with other waste fission product isotopes products.

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
