Dear Pete,

I am the temporary overall project manager for the preparation of the supplemental EISs for the Moore Ranch, Nichols Ranch and Hank, and Lost Creek proposed in-situ uranium recovery projects. In that role, I am coordinating the development of the draft SEISs for these three projects.

I am aware that Alan Bjornsen and Irene Yu each have sent their preliminary drafts to your for your group's review. Also, Patti Swain sent the initial 4 chapters to your attention for the same purpose. If it's okay, she won't be sending the rest of the document, given that the other two documents will give BLM the sense of where Patti's document is going.
