We have discussed EPA's request for an additional 30 calendar days to review the draft SEISs. Unfortunately this would cause quite a problem on our end as we have a contractor assisting us in reviewing the comments and developing responses and within 30 days their work will be complete. This would result in NRC resolving EPA's comments without contractor assistance which would result in a schedule delay.

Since the comment period has already been extended from 45 to 52 days, giving one additional week, we would like to propose that EPA provide comments by Feb. 8 and that the NRC staff be available via telecon to meet with EPA to answer any questions/resolve issues to expedite your review.
