NOTE: We have a current license amendment request in process dated 9 February 2010 (Mail Control Number 472579).

In response to the world-wide shortage of Molybdenum-99/Technitium-99m, you are likely receiving many requests from Medical Licensees to increase possession limits for Thallium-201. We request expedient consideration of the attached amendment request as current possession limits for Thallium-201 are insufficient for the anticipated increase in patient workload.
