Dear Sir/Madam:

PSEG Nuclear LLC ("PSEG") submits this letter with respect to notification made by Salem Generating Station to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection ("NJDEP") Hotline of a potential discharge at 23:25 hours on March 25, 2010 and assigned case number 10-03-25-2325-46 by Operator #35. This potential discharge was also reported to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") by PSEG.

Upon review of the details of the incident reported, PSEG determined that the leak reported was fully contained and cleaned up within 24 hours and that no discharge to the environment requiring notification to the State had occurred. PSEG is therefore submitting this letter to rescind its March 25, 2010 notification. Documentation of this event has been completed in accordance with the PSEG Event Classification Guide, Attachment 16, Spill/Discharge Reporting. Details of the incident were captured in the PSEG corrective action program under notification #20453635.

Although PSEG is rescinding the discharge notification, any additional information regarding this incident will be provided to NJDEP upon request.
