Dear Mr. Sipos:

In accordance with your E-mail request of March 12, 2010, enclosed is a CD disc containing the FORTRAN files for the MACCS2 code, v.1.13.1.

As I noted in my E-mail message of March 23, the Staff has previously sent the State of New York a CD disc containing an executable version of the MACCS2 code, v. 1.13.1, as you had requested earlier. That CD disc would allow the State to run the MACCS2 code without any need for the FORTRAN files. As I also noted, there is no contention regarding the FORTRAN files, and no reason appears why you would need them. Nonetheless, the Staff is providing these files to the State in response to your request. Please note that the State's use of the MACCS2 code with the FORTRAN files is governed by the terms of the non-disclosure agreement which the State has executed.
