SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Merrill:

In the NRC Form 314 dated January 5, 2010, and letter dated April 6, 2010, you indicated that you wished to release the location at J.C. Weadock Plant, 2555 North Weadock Highway, Essexville, Michigan for unrestricted use.

You also indicated that all activities authorized by license number 21-08606-10 have ceased and that radioactive materials possessed under this license have been transferred to RAM Services. Wisconsin license number 071-1234-01.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former location of use and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this location and it is suitable for unrestricted use.

Based on these conditions, your NRC license number 21-08606-10 is hereby terminated.
