Ms. Colleen Carol Casey is cognizant of this issue. This letter is to inform the NRC of the planned termination of our NRC license and formation of a joint venture between Upper Michigan Cardiovascular Associates (UMCA) and Marquette General Hospital (MGH). Signing of the final agreement is anticipated on April 28, 2010 after the MGH Board of Trustees meeting. We will request termination of our license as of May 15, 2010. Should anything delay this timing we will notify the NRC at once.

Following the completion of patient studies we will be transferring our sealed sources and remaining decay-in-storage waste to MGH. We will perform the necessary close-out surveys and wipe tests to demonstrate that no radioactivity remains in our facility. That data, map of surveyed areas and NRC form 314 will be faxed to your office. We will not release those areas for unrestricted use until we have your approval of the close-out.

The authorized users on the UMCA license are also authorized users at MGH. It is expected that MGH will own 51% of the joint venture. All sealed sources and short-lived waste to be transferred are materials currently used at MGH, namely Co-57, Cs-137, Ba-133, Tc-99m and Tl-201. The Radiation Safety Program at MGH will cover the policies and procedures of this joint venture. The MGH RSO will have authority over the uses of byproduct material by all imaging personnel and authorized users.


