SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF A TELEPHONE CONFERENCE PUBLIC MEETING
WITH SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT ON THE STATUS OF CHAPTER 19
HELD IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND ON APRIL 20, 2010

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a telephone conference meeting on April 20, 2010 with South Texas Project (STP) to discuss the status of Request for Additional Information (RAI) responses and plans towards resolution of Open Items in Chapter 19, "Probabilistic Risk Assessment and Severe Accident," in the STP Units 3 and 4 Combined License application.

The NRC and STP made brief opening remarks and introductions. NRC staff described its position on Chapter 19 RAI responses and open items. The group also discussed outstanding issues to be completed and scheduled.
