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Conference Call for the Fermi 3 COL Environmental Review

Monday, March 22, 2010, 2:00 PM Eastern Time

Purpose

To discuss project status, especially status of efforts to address the remaining RAIs.

Participants

U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC): Bruce Olson

Argonne National Laboratory (Argonne): John Hayse

Summary of Discussions and Associated Action Items

The summary of discussions during the conference call is presented below. Action items are identified below as **[ACTION ITEM]**.

Remaining RAI Responses and COLA Revision

- Westmoreland indicated that revision 2 of the COLA (which includes Rev 1 of the ER) would be sent to NRC on Thursday March 25. In addition, there will be a letter supplement that includes responses to remaining RAIs.
- Some notes on some RAI responses:
 - GE3.1-1 -- Updated version of Figure 4.3-2 will already be incorporated in the revised ER
 - some typographic errors in the responses to USACE RAIs were identified that may need to be hand-corrected. This includes a reference to the wrong RAI number on p. 3-32 (should be "8.2.4-4") and the use of "scope" instead of "slope" in the second bullet on p. 3-28.
- Olson requested that the items that are pertinent to the environmental review (i.e., not the entire COLA) should be posted electronically on Argonne's FTP site. That includes the ER portion of the COLA, responses to environmental RAIs, and the letter 21 response report. Detroit Edison will also send 2 copies of DVDs containing Rev. 2 of the COLA to Argonne. Westmoreland said he would post the files and send out the DVDs **[ACTION ITEM]**.
- Westmoreland will post the electronic CAD files for the revised site layout on the FTP site by Thursday March 25 or Friday March 26. These are simply electronic versions of figures provided in an earlier RAI response packet. **[ACTION ITEM]**
- After the submittal, Argonne will evaluate the submitted responses and supporting materials to determine the adequacy of each item for addressing the RAIs and will provide an updated status table to NRC by April 8th. **[ACTION ITEM]**.

RAIs Requesting Information not Provided for Docketing

- LaGory has requested the SMEs to determine which of the requested documents are needed and what form the information should be provided. He now has that information and will put together a summary and provide that to NRC **[ACTION ITEM]**.
- Westmoreland suggested that an option for closing out these document request RAIs would be for the SMEs to review and summarize information from requested documents (which are available via the virtual reading room) and then to incorporate the summaries into an NRC "audit report" that could be docketed and cited. An other option would be for Detroit Edison to provide summarized information that can be provided to NRC and used as references. This approach has been used before for Fermi 2 license reporting. Westmoreland will provide some examples and clarification of how this might work. **[ACTION ITEM]**

Groundwater Modeling

- Westmoreland reiterated that Detroit Edison will provide the final input files and an explanation of the drain package elevation selections by approximately March 25 **[ACTION ITEM]**. If needed, this may be the subject of a subsequent conference call.

Other Items

- Olson will be out of the office from March 25 to April 5th. Therefore, no conference call is currently planned for March 29.
- The next regularly scheduled management call will be Monday April 5th, 2-3 PM Eastern Time (1-2 Central Time).
- Call on April 8th, 2-4 PM Eastern Time (1-3 Central Time) to do a thorough review of the status of each RAI. Hayse will set up the call and provide call-in information to Olson. **[ACTION ITEM -- Done -- See below]**. If needed, the April 8th call (regularly scheduled call) will be used to complete this status review.
