**Purpose:**

**Discussion:**

- Patty gave an overview of how the MOU came about and the status of the MOU
  - Comments on the MOU from OGC and staff are ready to go back to BLM HQ
  - NRC lead, BLM as cooperating agency for license application
  - NRC cooperating agency, BLM as lead for Plan of Operations
  - MOU to be signed by Feb 09 according to BLM HQ
- BLM feels that MOU should be signed at the state level
- BLM in the state and field offices have not had a chance to review the MOU
- BLM provided NRC with a copy of the new DOI implementation of NEPA regulations and a copy of their MOU with DEQ
- BLM does not feel that they can go with an EA for these ISL facilities because of the public interest in these applications and because the GEIS is inadequate
- BLM's main concerns are water quality and cumulative impacts at these sites

**Questions:**

- Does the MOU include state contacts?
- At what point does the NRC engage with other agencies and notify them that they are undertaking an environmental review of an ISL application?
- Does the reducing nature of the CBM process and the oxidizing nature of the ISL process cause a problem? This needs to be addressed in the EAs.
- Should NRC have quarterly calls with BLM and DEQ regarding current and future applications?
