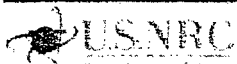

A prehistoric archaeological site was discovered during the cultural resource survey conducted at the site by the applicant's (UR-Energy USA) consultant. It was determined that that the site was eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. Subsequently, a treatment plan was prepared by the applicant's consultant, and was approved by the BLM, and concurred by the SHPO.
