During a brief of Crystal River Reactor Building Dome Delamination Problem to my Division Director Kriss Kennedy on October 13, he asked me a question of how many days of concrete curing time between the new concrete pour for the containment wall opening and the application of retensioning force for the tendons during the Steam Generator or Reactor Head Replacements. I did not give him an answer because I did not participate any concrete openings with the tendons during the Steam Generator or Reactor Head Replacement Projects.
