Proposed Addition of a Secondary Water
Chemistry Monitoring Program

Dear Sir:

Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License", and attachments thereto.

This application seeks to incorporate operating conditions for a secondary water chemistry monitoring program into Facility Operating License DPR-64. This change is intended as the response to a request by the NRC dated August 1, 1979.

The Authority considers this Application to be a supplement to its application dated August 31, 1978 (IPO-151) which requested Technical Specification changes to incorporate Secondary Water Chemistry limiting condition for operations and surveillance requirements. In a phone conversation on October 12, 1979 between Messrs. Olshan and Webb of your staff and our Mr. Wilverding it was indicated that said change request should not be considered withdrawn. In IPO-151 the Authority classified the Technical Specification change request to be Class III pursuant to 10 CFR §170.22, for which a fee of \$4,000 was paid under protest. The Authority has reclassified its original application as a Class II because the change as requested in this supplement is administrative in nature and has no safety or environmental significance. The prescribed fee for a Class II amendment is \$1,200. Therefore, the Authority is entitled to a refund in the amount of \$2,800 as an overpayment of fee.

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In support of this application we are enclosing forty (40) copies of the Safety Evaluation corresponding to the proposed addition to the Operating License.
