
Dear Sir:

On October 3, 1980, Mr. Barry Manili, Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, Physical Security Licensing Branch, Division of Safeguards was contacted and agreed to extend the date for responses to questions regarding the Indian Point Unit #3 Nuclear Power Plant Security Force Training and Qualification Plan.

The request for extension was due to the Safeguards Contingency Plan being approved and amended to the Indian Point Unit #3 operating license effective September 12, 1980.
