The Authority submits herewith for filing three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License", and attachments thereto.

This application seeks to amend the Section 6.0 Administrative Controls of Appendix A to the Operating License to reflect recent organization and management title changes which have taken place at the Authority.

It should be noted that one of the changes shown on the enclosed Figure 6.2-1 (i.e., the placement of the Shift Technical Advisor under the Technical Services Superintendent) has already been requested in our letter dated December 30, 1980 (IPN-80-118). It is included here for completeness since this requested change has not been approved as of this writing.

The corresponding organization and management title changes to the organization figures in Appendix B to the Operating License have already been requested in our letter dated February 27, 1981. These changes are not included here because that request includes a complete restructuring and revision of Appendix B.


