The revisions will be made available for public comment on June 15, 2010 with a request for comment by July 15, 2010. We request NRC's comments by June 1, 2010. The changes to Article 175 are identified by underlined additions/square-bracketed [deletions] text and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations.
