Task Order 21 Statement of Work (SOW)
Entitled: Public Meeting Notice System

A. Background

The Public Meeting Notice System (PMNS) is a web application that allows the NRC to share specific public meeting information with internal NRC personnel as well as the public wanting to participate in public meetings scheduled by the NRC. It is a ColdFusion based web application with a Sybase database.

B. Objective

The objective of this task order is to support, enhance and expand the current public meeting notice system.

C. Scope

The contractor shall perform application systems maintenance for the Public Meeting Notice System (PMNS) following NRC's Project Management Methodology (PMM) as outlined on the web site at <http://www.internal.nrc.gov/pmm>. The contractor shall also produce the necessary documentation for the work performed as defined in subparagraph, "Maintenance", listed below.

D. Requirements

The contractor shall perform application systems maintenance for the Public Meeting Notice System (PMNS), which includes but is not limited to:

- Following the Release Lifecycle
- Development and maintenance of PMM Documentation
- Maintaining all documentation in ClearCase
- Maintaining CR's in ClearQuest
- Following Change Management
- Following Quality Assurance Practices

In addition, the contractor shall:

- Be responsible for maintaining and operating the current PMNS system.
- Receive, evaluate and maintain Change Requests via Rational ClearQuest system as required by the PMM.
- Develop test scripts and test any new releases requested by the TOM.
- Create transition plans for each new release requested by the TOM.
- Support PMNS users on the production release.

All system related work products, including report generation code and queries, will be maintained in the Configuration Management (CM) library that supports the Delivery Order 21 Task Order maintenance activities.

E. Place and Period of Performance

Most efforts under this SOW can be performed at the contractor site. Access to the NRC facilities shall be provided by the NRC, as required, during normal working hours for the duration of this SOW.

F. Schedule of Deliverables

Maintenance requests shall be performed within the time negotiated with the NRC TOM for each system release.

G. Expertise/Skills

Demonstrated senior level experience in ColdFusion application development, creating relational databases in Sybase and writing stored procedures. Competency in technical, written communication, and analytical skills as demonstrated through prior assignments in the technical support area.
