## Tom Joyce

Good evening. I am Tom Joyce, president and chief nuclear officer for PSEG Nuclear. I am responsible for our Salem and Hope Creek Generating Stations.

On behalf of PSEG, we look forward to working with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the public on our application for an early site permit as we explore the possibility of building a new nuclear plant here in Salem County.

At PSEG, we understand our obligation to the local community, the environment and our friends, families and coworkers to provide safe, reliable, economic and green energy.

We operate our plants within a culture of safety and transparency.

We encourage our employees to raise issues and to be open on how we can do things better. There are always lessons to be learned.

Our success is made possible by our 1500 employees.

There are no surprises. Not in our operations and certainly not with our stakeholders. As I say to our employees – there is no new nuclear, without good old nuclear.

I have over 30 years of experience in the commercial nuclear power industry. I have spent the past five years at PSEG.

Personally, I have never worked with a better group of people or in a better community than Salem County.

Whoever said it can't be done has never been to Salem County.

This community is about partnerships.

Over our 30 years of operation, we have been a partner with this community.
