# Summary of Proposed Changes



#### SAR

- A new Compliance Item Commitment is made for Support Equipment and attributes relied upon for worker actions.
- A new Table is added that identifies Administrative Control boundary are not included in this table (such items are attributes which may be within the administrative IROFS the table. IROFS and components with safe-by-design that meets the definition of Support Equipment is included in equipment, and corresponding attributes. Only equipment address separately). - A paragraph is added to delineate that management measures are also applied to Support Equipment attributes

# Summary of Proposed Changes
